

Blacksmithing Guidelines & Safety

- **All Museum rules on Safety and Harassment are in effect.** Those who cannot or will not behave safely (and kindly) may be asked to leave, for the day or forever. No warnings, no refunds!

SAFETY

- **Clothing:** Legs and Toes covered at all times.
Natural fibers - NO synthetics or blends!
- **Leather or natural fiber boots or shoes only.**
- **Proper Safety Glasses:** on whenever near fire, forging, filing, etc.
- **Ear Protection:** on when needed for loud hammering or machine use.
- **Leather or fire-resistant apron:** Optional to protect clothing and burns.
- **Nametags:** On and Visible. Chalk name on anvil, too
- **Burns: Immediately cool the area in a Slack tub or running water.**
Learn and practice avoidance methods...



CONDUCT

- **Communicate** with those around you. Move carefully.
- **Visitors:** We are part of an active museum. Help keep visitors safe.
- **Drive safely** on museum grounds. Park only in designated spots
- **Help Others to Behave Safely-** Point out problems nicely. When reminded or corrected, say only "thank you!"
- **ASK** when unsure. Tell instructors about your learning needs.
- **Ask to Borrow Tools-** get *personal* permission.
- **Return Promptly**- to the person/place you got it as soon as you are done with it. Don't pass it on!
- **We are Volunteers:** Pick up your own litter and tools, help with at least one task each day. Ask how you can help. (Open, close, slack tubs, trash)
- **Class Goals:** Learn safety and coal fires. Try blacksmithing. **Have safe fun!**
